Important Safety Reminders

As our children become more confident and independent around the school environment, we would like to remind all families of a few important safety procedures that help us keep everyone safe during arrival, collection, and after-school times.

Entry and Exit Doors

Please ensure that the magnetic front door leading into the piazza is always closed properly behind you and securely locked after entering or exiting. The adjacent glass door should also be closed at all times once passing through.

We ask parents to please not allow children to run ahead independently through the doors into or out of the piazza area. We understand that many of our children are growing in confidence and independence and are eager to move about on their own; however, for safety reasons, children must remain under close adult supervision during arrival and dismissal times.

Playground Supervision After School

If you remain on the playground after school for your child to play for a few minutes with friends, please keep a watchful eye on your children at all times. Please respect the 'lock-up' of the fantasy play areas, as they need to be cleaned and prepared for the next day. Once your child has been collected from class, they are under the care and responsibility of the parent or guardian. Teachers have officially handed over supervision at this point, and the school cannot be held liable during this time.

Prompt Collection After Extra-Murals

We kindly ask parents to please collect children promptly after extra-mural activities. If your child attends aftercare, they will be escorted there directly. However, if your child is being collected after an extra-mural activity, please ensure you arrive on time so that the extra-mural provider may safely hand your child over to you.

Tower of Tins - Mandela Day Reminder

Our “Tower of Tins” initiative continues as we head towards Mandela Day, and we warmly invite families to take part by sending a tin of non-perishable food. 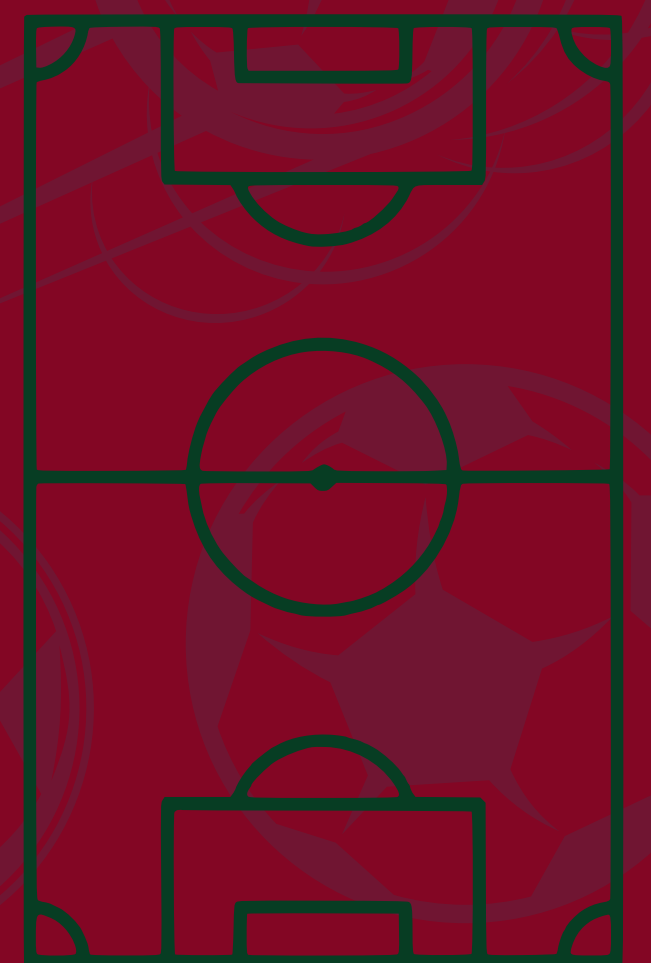
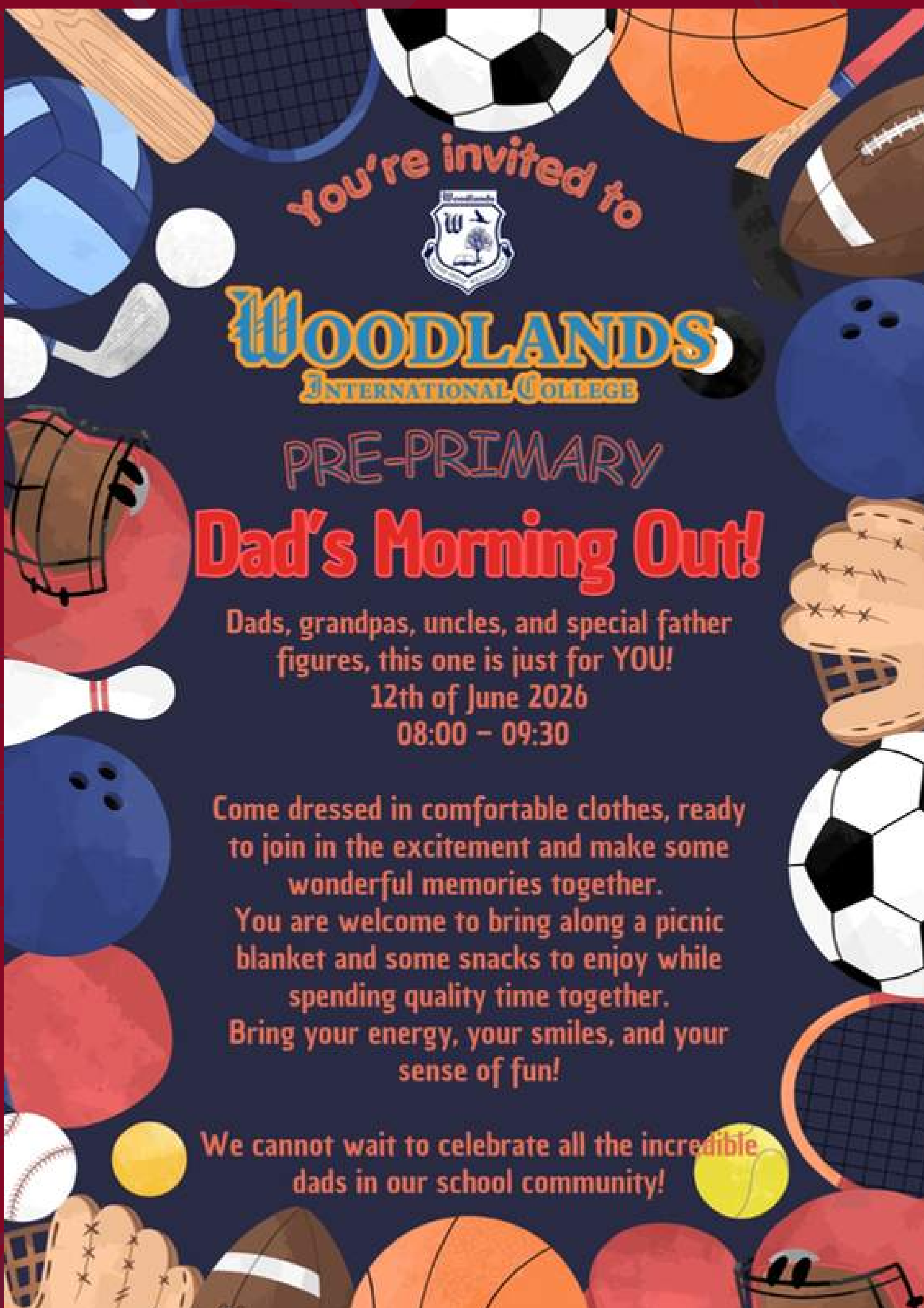
